In 2009, he was inducted into the Canadian Professional Speakers Hall of Fame and in 2018, the Canadian Disability Hall welcomed him for his significant role in advocacy for people with special needs. But what Alvin is most proud of is since 1976, he has been directly involved in raising over two hundred million dollars for charity.
